SBB'S ATS TREND OF THE DAY:

The Rockets are 0-10 ATS (-13.05 ppg) with less than two days rest off a road game after a game in which their opponent shot under 40% from the field.

SDQL TEXT: team=Rockets and rest<2 and p:A and po:FPG<40 and date>=20141117

SBB'S OU TREND OF THE DAY:

The Clippers are 8-0-1 OU (17.61 ppg) after playing as a home favorite last game.

SDQL TEXT: team=Clippers and p:HF and date>=20171030

SBB'S PLAYER TREND OF THE DAY:

The Thunder are 7-0 ATS (9.21 ppg) on the road off a win where Russell Westbrook scored a least 15 fewer points than he did 2 games ago.

SDQL TEXT: team=Thunder and A and p:W and Thunder:Russell Westbrook:p:points + 15<=Thunder:Russell Westbrook:pp:points and date>=20160510

SBB'S SDQL CHOICE TREND:

The Thunder are 8-0 ATS (10.06 ppg) off a win in a road game in which they had at least twice as many assists as turnovers.

SDQL TEXT: team=Thunder and p:AW and 2<=p:ATR and date>=20161126

TODAY FROM SPORTSBOOK BREAKERS:
