SBB's NFL PLAY ON ATS TREND:

The Ravens are 10-0-1 ATS (9.4 ppg) since 2008 when their last game went over the total by at least 14 points and they are not 6+ point dogs.

SDQL TEXT: team=Ravens and season>= 2008 and p:ou margin>=14 and line<6

SBB's NFL PLAY AGAINST TREND:

The Jaguars are 0-11 ATS (-10.9 ppg) since September 30, 2012 when facing a team that has allowed more than 4.5 yards per carry season-to-date.

SDQL TEXT: team=Jaguars and 4.4<oA(o:YPPRA) and date>=20120930

SBB's TOP NFL PLAYER TREND:

The Broncos are 9-0 OU (9.0 ppg) since October 7, 2012 after a win in which Demaryius Thomas had a reception of 40+ yards.

SDQL TEXT: 40<=Broncos:Demaryius Thomas:p:longest reception and p:W and date>=20121007

NFL BIBLE ACTIVE TREND:

TEN011: The Titans are 10-0 OU (12.7 ppg) since October 29, 2001 as a road dog when facing a team that has forced an average of at least six punts per game season-to-date.

SDQL TEXT: team=Titans and AD and oA(o:punts)>=6 and date>=20011029

SBB's NCAA PLAY ON ATS TREND:

Florida Atlantic is 12-0-1 ATS (13.2 ppg) since November 26, 2011 after a road loss.

SDQL TEXT: team=FATL and p:AL and date>=20111126

SBB's NCAA PLAY AGAINST TREND:

Arkansas is 0-12 ATS since October 16, 2004 when the total is under 72 when facing a team that won by at least 34 points last game while allowing less than 13 points.

SDQL TEXT: team=ARK and op:margin>=34 and opo:points<13 and total<72 and date>=20041016

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SBB's NFL O/UTREND:

The Jaguars are 0-10 OU (-11.0 ppg) since October 16, 2011 after a loss where they had a rushing touchdown.

SDQL TEXT: team=Jaguars and 0<max:p:rushing touchdowns and p:L and date>=20111016

SBB's NCAA O/UTREND:

Notre Dame is 0-7 OU (-7.5 ppg) since September 29, 2007 as an underdog or more than 10 points.

SDQL TEXT: team=NOTD and line>10 and date>=20070929

SBB's NFL SUPER SYSTEM

Teams that allowed at least 18.75 points less than expected last game are 68-45-5 ATS. Active on Detroit.

SDQL TEXT: p:dpa<=-18.75

SBB's NCAA SUPER SYSTEM

Teams that scored at least 22 points less than expected in their last game are 64-93-5 OU. Active on Cal and Missouri.

SDQL TEXT: p:dps<=-22

PICK SIXTY SPORTS WEEKLY TIP:

Every season there is a couple of hot trends involving bye weeks and so far this year we are seeing a run of 7 overs and 1 under for teams off the break, including the Cardinals-Broncos game against each other in Week 5 (SDQL Text: season = 2014 and week = p:week + 2). This week's tip focuses on a couple of road teams returning from the break with trends to consider along with our Best Bet.

New Orleans is a small road dog in Detroit Sunday and the line has bounced between 2.5 and 3 points. If you like the Saints, be sure and get at least +3 because dogs up to +2.5 in this spot are just 17-28 ATS since 2001 while dogs of exactly +3 points show a 16-9-3 ATS record. Access that info with this code:

SDQL Text: 0, 3<=t:line<=2.5, 3 and week = p:week + 2 and REG and season >= 2001

The Chiefs are available with +4.5 points for their game against San Diego and while divisional dogs have generally struggled off a bye, the Chiefs have a big ace up their sleeve in coach Andy Reid. With Philly, Reid was nearly unbeatable off the bye and this week we're getting added value thanks to the Chargers win over Oakland. Mid-range divisional dogs in this spot are 5-0-1 ATS (SDQL Text: 3 <= line <= 5.5 and week = p:week + 2 and REG and A and DIV and op:DIV and op:W) and as KC looks to hit .500 on the season, we'll back them to cover.
