### SBB's NFL PLAY ON ATS TREND:

The Saints are 13-0-1 ATS (14.9 ppg) since October 23, 2011 as a home favorite when they won their last two home games.

**SDQL TEXT:** team=Saints and HF and Sum(0<margin@team and season and H,N=2)=2 and date>=20111023

### SBB's NCAA PLAY ON ATS TREND:

Duke is 14-0 ATS (10.1 ppg) since 2000 on the road when not more than a TD dog, if they are not undefeated this season.

**SDQL TEXT:** team=DUKE and A and line<=7 and season>=2000 and tS(L)>0

### SBB's NFL PLAY AGAINST TREND:

The Cowboys are 0-13 ATS (-12.2 ppg) since November 1993 as a road favorite of more than four points when they won their last two road games.

**SDQL TEXT:** team=Cowboys and A and line<-4 and Sum((W)@team and season and A,N=2)=2 and 19931101<=date

### SBB's NCAA PLAY AGAINST TREND:

Fresno State is 0-12-1 ATS (-8.3 ppg) since 2002 as a favorite between weeks 5 and 14 of the season after a game where they allowed at least 45 points.

**SDQL TEXT:** team=FRES and season>=2002 and po:points>=45 and F and 14>=week>=5

### SBB's TOP NFL PLAYER TREND:

The Fortyniners are 10-0-1 ATS (10.5 ppg) since November 22, 2009 on the road after a home game in which Vernon Davis had fewer than 25 receiving yards.

**SDQL TEXT:** A and Fortyniners:Vernon Davis:p:receiving yards<25 and p:H and date>=20091122

## SBB'S NFL O/U TREND:

The Cardinals are 10-0-1 ATS (7.9 ppg) since October 30, 2011 when facing a team whose defense recorded 4-plus sacks in their last game.

**SDQL TEXT:** team=Cardinals and 4<=op:sacks and date>=20111030

## SBB'S NCAA O/U TREND:

Ohio State is 0-9 OU (-13.4 ppg) since 2008 as an underdog of no more than a TD.

**SDQL TEXT:** team=OHST and 7>=line>0 and season>=2008

## SBB'S NFL SUPER SYSTEM

Teams are 42-32-1 ATS facing a team they lost to by at least 38 points last time they faced this team. Active on Tampa Bay.

**SDQL TEXT:** P:margin<=-38

## SBB'S NCAA SUPER SYSTEM

Teams that won last game to snap a 4+ game losing streak are 90-120-3 OU. Active on UConn and NC State.

**SDQL TEXT:** p:W and pp:L and ppp:L and pppp:L and ppppp:L

## PICK SIXTY SPORTS WEEKLY TIP:

Miami is in Detroit this week looking to extend their win streak to four-straight games but they'll have to be careful against these Lions. So far this season Detroit has proven that being out of time outs, outrushed and out-yarded does not necessarily mean they are out of the football game. The Lions are coming off a bye and expecting the return of WR Calvin Johnson, too, so if Miami plans to grind out another road win they are going to have to continue the scoring pace that has crept them into the league's top ten at 26.4 points per game.

**SDQL Text:** A and tS(ATSW, N=5) = 4 and month = 11 and 42.5 <= total <= 49.5 and season >= 1997

The Dolphins have been a steady producer with 389 yards per game the past five and they've been rewarding bettors with four ATS wins during that span. Since 1997, November games with a total between 42.5 and 49.5 are 31-15-3 O/U (67-percent) when the road team has covered four of five and with the news of Calvin Johnson's return, this line is starting to gather steam. The Lions have stayed under in five of the past six but their offense has been underperforming and some of the opponents they faced (Jets, Bills, Vikings) contributed very little to the scoring. Small non-Conference road dogs in this spot have averaged 25 points per game in this spot and as Detroit tries to kick-start its offense off the bye, we'll look for these teams to clear the number.

**Pick:** Take the Dolphins and Lions OVER 43.5 points
