The Packers are 10-0 ATS since January 23, 2011 on grass surface vs a divisional opponent

SDQL TEXT: team=Packers and surface=grass and DIV and date>=20110123

SBB'S NCAA PLAY ON ATS TREND:

Ohio is 13-0-1 ATS since October 2004 if they're not more than a nine point favorite, when they won by more than 10 points last game while scoring between 24 and 42 points.

SDQL TEXT: team='OHU' and date>=20041001 and p:margin>=11 and 42>=p:points>=24 and line>-9

SBB'S NFL PLAY AGAINST TREND:

The Chargers are 0-10 ATS since December 20, 2009 as a favorite after playing as a dog.

SDQL TEXT: team=Chargers and F and p:D and date>=20091220

SBB'S NCAA PLAY AGAINST TREND:

Miami is 0-11 ATS since December 2004 as between a 5 and 13 point favorite with less than five losses on the year and they are facing a team which scored less than 42 points last game.

SDQL TEXT: -13<=line<=-5 and date>=20041201 and team='MIAF' and op:points<42 and losses<

SBB'S TOP NFL PLAYER TREND:

Michael Vick is 0-8 ATS in his career following a game where he threw for at least 170 yards while completing less than 15 passes.

SDQL TEXT: MVick:p:completions<15 and MVick:p:passing yards>=170

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SBB's NFL O/U TREND:

The Cowboys are 12-0 OU since December 10, 2006 at home when facing a team completing at least 65.1% of their passes on the season, which threw for less than 385 yards last game.

SDQL TEXT: team=Cowboys and H and oA(CP)>=65.1 and op:PY<385 and date>=20061210

SBB's NFL SUPER SYSTEM

Teams which are favorites after winning by less than 17 points as a home dog are 59-88-1 ATS. Active on San Diego.

SDQL TEXT: F and p:HDW and p:margin<17

PICK SIXTY SPORTS WEEKLY TIP:

The theme for Sunday's game between the Baltimore Ravens and Miami Dolphins is "Bounce Back" as each team looks to shake off an ugly showing in Week 4. Baltimore's 25-20 loss at Buffalo was plagued by turnovers while Miami fell victim to a Saints team who have not lost at home on Monday Night Football since 2008. The Dolphins turned the ball over four times, gave up 413 passing yards, failed to protect their quarterback and lost the turnover battle 4-to-1 yet oddsmakers are still doling out the token the 3-point home field advantage in this game against the reigning Super Bowl champs. So much for "wearing a target" all season!

Small non-divisional home faves on grass are 57-104-7 ATS (35-percent) since 2008 and Miami with a bye on-deck, here is an angle to consider that is 17-3 ATS since 2009 when backing the road dog (Ravens):

SDQL: H and week + 2 = tn:week and -3 <= t:line <= -.5 and season >= 2009

Miami's pass protection ranks dead last in the league (18 sacks allowed). Ryan Tannehill, meet Terrell Suggs. Take BALTIMORE to cover.

SDQL TEXT: team=BAY and 81.5>=total>=68 and 45>=op:points>=20 and season>=2010

SBB's NCAA SUPER SYSTEM

Teams are 50-77-2 ATS as between 10.5 and 17 point favorites coming off a win as a home underdog. Active with Buffalo.

SDQL TEXT: p:HDW and -17<=line<=-10.5
