The Magic are 0-15 OU (-13.13 ppg) at home off a double-digit loss as a dog in which they had at least five turnovers more than their season-to-date average.

The Cavaliers are 0-11 ATS (-14.64 ppg) at home after Kevin Love had a double double last game.

The Celtics are 0-11 ATS (-12.95 ppg) with rest off a double-digit win in which they shot over 55% from the field.

SDQL TEXT: team=Celtics and 0<rest and 10<=p:margin and 55<=p:FGP and date>=20121221
