### SBB'S OU TREND OF THE DAY:

The Raptors are 0-10 OU (-17.45 ppg) since Jan 03, 2017 on the road off a game as a favorite that had eight-plus lead changes.

**SDQL TEXT:** *team=Raptors and A and p:F and p:LC>=8 and date>=20170103*

### SBB'S PLAYER TREND OF THE DAY:

The Raptors are 11-0 OU (16.73 ppg) since Feb 06, 2015 off a loss as a favorite in which Demar Derozan shot under 45 percent was the team's high scorer.

**SDQL TEXT:** *team=Raptors and p:FL and Raptors:Demar Derozan:p:FPG<45 and Raptors:Demar Derozan:p:points=max:p:points and date>=20150206*

### SBB'S SDQL CHOICE TREND:

The Spurs are 10-0 OU (17.15 ppg) since Apr 02, 2017 facing an opponent averaging less than 20 fouls per game.

**SDQL TEXT:** *team=Spurs and oA(fouls)<20 and date>=20170402*
