The Thunder are 0-19 OU (-14.32 ppg) since Dec 12, 2012 at home with more than one day of rest when they are off two straight wins as a favorite.

SDQL TEXT: team=Thunder and H and 1<rest and pp:WF and p:WF and date>=20121212

SBB'S PLAYER TREND OF THE DAY:

The Grizzlies are 12-0 ATS (7.50 ppg) since Oct 30, 2010 as a home favorite after a game as a road dog in which Mike Conley had fewer than 10 points.

SDQL TEXT: team=Grizzlies and HF and p:AD and Grizzlies:Mike Conley:p:points<10 and date>=20101030

SBB'S SDQL CHOICE TREND:

The Timberwolves are 0-12 ATS (-7.21 ppg) since Feb 09, 2007 as a favorite off a win in which they shot 50% or better from beyond the arc with at least 10 attempts.

SDQL TEXT: team=Timberwolves and F and p:W and 10<=p:TPA and 50<=p:TPP and date>=20070209
