SBB'S NFL PLAY ON ATS TREND:

The Redskins are 11-0-2 ATS since October 13, 1996 as a road dog on grass after playing as a favorite

SDQL TEXT: team=Redskins and AD and surface=grass and p:F and date>=19961013

SBB'S NCAA PLAY ON ATS TREND:

Auburn is 15-0-1 ATS (9.1 ppg) since 1997 when they aren't more than 21 point favorites or 10 point dogs and won by between 17 and 30 last game as between a 5 and 31 point favorite.

SDQL TEXT: team= AUB and season>=1997 and 10>=line>=-21 and 30>=p:margin>=17 and -31<=p:line<=-5

SBB'S NFL PLAY AGAINST TREND:

The Buccaneers are 0-9-1 ATS since December 2006 as a home dog between away games.

SDQL TEXT: team=Buccaneers and HD and p:A and n:A and date>=20061201

SBB'S NCAA PLAY AGAINST TREND:

Purdue is 0-14 ATS (-15.8 ppg) since October 25, 2003 when they have one loss on the season and aren't 20+ point favorites.

SDQL TEXT: date>=20031025 and losses=1 and line>-20 and team= PUR

SBB'S TOP NFL PLAYER TREND:

Demaryius Thomas is 0-7 ATS (-10.0 ppg) coming off a game where the total was under 51 and he had at least 103 receiving yards.

SDQL TEXT: Broncos:DThomas:p:receiving yards>=103 and p:total<51

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SBB's NFL O/U TREND:

The Chiefs are 0-15-1 OU since December 05, 2010 when their opponent's season-to-date average pass attempts per game is greater than 35.

SDQL TEXT: team=Chiefs and oA(passes)>35 and date>=20101205

SBB's NCAA O/U TREND:

Alabama is 0-10 OU when the total is over 50 and they are playing a team averaging less than 30.8 points per game.

SDQL TEXT: team=ALA and total>52 and oA(o:points)<30.8

SBB's NFL SUPER SYSTEM

Teams which gained at least 500 total yards in week one are 9-1 ATS in week two. Active on Denver.

SDQL TEXT: week=2 and p:TY>=500

SBB's NCAA SUPER SYSTEM

Teams which started the season 2-0 after winning two or fewer games last season are 17-31 ATS in week three. Active against Illinois, Boston College

SDQL TEXT: game number = 3 and p:W and pp:W and Sum(W@team and season)[team and season -1]<=2

PICK SIXTY SPORTS WEEKLY TIP:

In last week's tip sheet we looked at Seattle's tendency to start the season with low scoring games away from home. This week we can scroll to the other end of the September scoring chart to see a Detroit Lions team who ranks in the top 5 for both Over/Under percentage and scoring margin "Over" the total the past 10 years.

Detroit's (11-6-1 O/U) vast majority of overs were losses but since Jim Schwartz took over in 2009, the Lions have learned how to score. When it's a non-divisional opponent in the first three months of the season Detroit's record soars to 22-5-1 O/U (82-percent) and this code shows their record away from home in September through November:

SDQL: team = Lions and A and NDIV and season >= 2009 and month in [9, 10, 11]

That's 10 overs, 1 under and a push with games going over the mark by an average of more than eight points per game. The line for Detroit at Arizona is 47.5 and we like this game to go over the number.

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Note: It is not SportsBook Breakers recommendation to make plays based solely on one trend (our selections at killercappers.com don't). Weigh these trends along with other factors accordingly.
