The Trailblazers are 13-0 ATS (9.04 ppg) as a dog when they are off two consecutive games in which they had 3 or fewer double digit scorers.

SBB'S OUTREND OF THE DAY:

The Heat are 0-11 OU (-11.50 ppg) as a dog off a road game in which they had less than 40% of the total rebounds.

SDQL TEXT: team=Heat and D and p:A and p:rebounds / (p:rebounds + po:rebounds)<=.40 and date>=20080327

SBB'S PLAYER TREND OF THE DAY:

The Nuggets are 0-9 OU (-12.33 ppg) as a favorite after Nikola Jokic had at least 5 turnovers last game.

SDQL TEXT: team=Nuggets and F and 5<=Nuggets:Nikola Jokic:p:turnovers and date>=20161226

SBB'S SDQL CHOICE TREND:

The Nuggets are 0-11 ATS (-10.77 ppg) off a win in which they shot 50% or better from beyond the arc with at least 10 attempts.

SDQL TEXT: team=Nuggets and p:W and 10<=p:TPA and 50<=p:TPP and date>=20160304
