The Seventysixers are 10-0 ATS (6.05 ppg) as a home dog with rest coming off a win.

SBB'S OUTREND OF THE DAY:

The Spurs are 0-11 OU (-13.23 ppg) as a favorite off a win in a road game in which they scored less than 15% of their points from free throws.

SBB'S PLAYER TREND OF THE DAY:

The Raptors are 12-0 OU (17.21 ppg) off a loss as a favorite in which Demar Derozan shot under 45 percent and was their high scorer.

SBB'S SDQL CHOICE TREND:

The Lakers are 0-10-1 ATS (-7.55 ppg) as a dog with rest coming off a win in a home game in which their opponent shot under 40% from the field.

SDQL TEXT: team=Lakers and D and 0<rest and p:HW and po:FGP<40 and date>=20120426

SPORTSBOOK BREAKERS NBA won its lone play Wednesday by 32 points on Detroit. SBB has a solid 4.5-STAR Total of the Day going in a late evening matchup Thursday. The play is backed by six solid trends and systems with a couple of very solid systems. Get this play guaranteed for just \$20 in web debit value.

SPORTSBOOK BREAKERS NFL won its top play on CAR, finishing 2-2 on the weekend and winning both 4.5-STAR Selections. SBB is now 82-67 this season and an impressive 48-32 in the playoffs the past six seasons, using dozens of exclusive playoff systems it has developed. SBB will post its divisional round plays later Thursday.
