The Bills are 11-0 ATS (7.7 ppg) since December 20, 1997 as a 7+ dog when they lost and failed to cover their last two games

SDQL TEXT: team=Bills and 7<=line and streak<=-2 and ats streak<=-2 and date>=19971220

SBB's NCAA PLAY ON ATS TREND:

Utah is 14-0 ATS (12.2 ppg) since 1998 since as between a 6 and 18 point underdog between games 2 and 12 of the season, if they are coming off a game with normal rest.

SDQL TEXT: team=UTAH and 18>=line>=6 and season>=1998 and 13>game number>1 and p:rest<=6

SBB's NFL PLAY AGAINST TREND:

The Jaguars are 0-10 ATS (-11.8 ppg) since September 30, 2012 when facing a team that has allowed more than 4.4 yards per carry season-to-date.

SDQL TEXT: team=Jaguars and oA(o:YPR) >4.4 and date>=20120930

SBB's NCAA PLAY AGAINST TREND:

Michigan is 0-11 ATS (-14.1 ppg) since 2008 after a home loss when they allowed more than 17 points.

SDQL TEXT: team=MICH and p:HL and po:points>17 and season>=2008

SBB's TOP NFL PLAYER TREND:

The Lions are 0-12-1 ATS (-7.3 ppg) past week one when Calvin Johnson had at least seven receptions in a loss the last time they faced this team.

SDQL TEXT: Lions:CJohnson:P:receptions>=7 and P:L and week>1

SDQL TEXT: team=Eagles and surface=artificial and p:DL and date>=20081127

SBB's NCAA O/U TREND:

Baylor is 14-0 OU (16.9 ppg) since 2011 in games where the total is no more than 70.

SDQL TEXT: team=BAY and total<=70 and season>=2011

SBB's NFL SUPER SYSTEM

Teams that lost by a TD in overtime last game are 43-34-3 ATS. Active on Denver.

SDQL TEXT: p:overtime==1 and p:margin==-6

SBB's NCAA SUPER SYSTEM

Teams that are averaging at least 52 points per game in at least game three of the season are 139-101-7 ATS. Active on Baylor.

SDQL TEXT: game number>=3 and tApoints>52

PICK SIXTY SPORTS WEEKLY TIP:

The New Orleans Saints are home from a good old fashioned butt kicking on national TV last week and at 1-3, find themselves swirled into a 'Sky is falling' media circus in the Big Easy. It's an unfamiliar situation for a coach with the fourth best record in football since 2006, but oddsmakers believe Sean Payton (74-42 SU, .638) will make immediate adjustments, starting Sunday vs. the Tampa Bay Bucs.

Speaking of unfamiliar situations, Tampa Bay is off a straight-up win as a 7.5-point road dog last week in Pittsburgh. As you will see by the noted SDQL text, conference road teams in this spot have done alright the following week (10-4 ATS), winning six of the 14 games straight-up. The scoring average (18.7 PPG) suggests the Bucs will need sound defense to win this game but from what we've seen the past month, Tampa's D cannot be relied on to stop the Saints offense for an entire 60 minutes.

The question then, is how many points will the Saints score? Atlanta rolled up 56 on the Bucs so surely Drew Brees should be good for at least 40. Perhaps, but the Saints have a bye on-deck followed by a series of tough matchups. This team is out of sync and their scoring has dropped in four consecutive weeks. The Saints will use this as a tune up game to head into the break on a positive note. Look for an emphasis on running the ball, limiting mistakes and strong tackling by the defense as this game stays under the big number.

Take the Bucs-Saints UNDER 48.5
