SBB'S NFL PLAY ON ATS TREND:

The Packers are 8-0 ATS since December 2006 as a dog of more than three points in a game played on grass.

SDQL TEXT: team=Packers and line>3 and surface=grass and date>=20061201

SBB'S NCAA PLAY ON ATS TREND:

Toledo is 10-0 ATS since October 25, 2008 as a 3-18 point dog with less than 9 days rest in the first 11 games of the season.

SDQL TEXT: team=TOL and 18>=line>=3 and date>=20081025 and rest<9 and game number<12

SBB'S NFL PLAY AGAINST TREND:

The Lions are 0-9-1 ATS since Sep 18, 2005 as a favorite, or not a dog of more than two points vs a divisional opponent on a Sunday in the first 16 weeks of the season.

SDQL TEXT: team=Lions and line<=2 and DIV and day=Sunday and week<=16 and date>=20050918

SBB'S NCAA PLAY AGAINST TREND:

Eastern Michigan is 0-16 ATS since November 11, 2006 if not 28+ point dogs, after a game where they allowed less than 25 points.

SDQL TEXT: team=EMCH and po:points<25 and date>=20061111 and line<28

SBB'S TOP NFL PLAYER TREND:

Calvin Johnson is 0-10-1 ATS (-7.8 ppg) in his career when he caught at least seven passes in a loss the last time he faced this team.

SDQL TEXT: Lions:CJohnson:P:receptions>=7 and P:L

NFL BIBLE ACTIVE TREND:

The Cardinals are 0-10 OU (-10.4 ppg) since 2008 on the road when facing a divisional opponent for the first time of the season.

SDQL TEXT: team=Cardinals and A and DIV and season=P:season+1 and season>=2008

USER Submitted: JAY1: NFL System: Home dogs against non-divisional teams are 0-11-1 OU in week one when the total is at least 45. Active on Carolina.

SDQL TEXT: week=1 and NDIV and HD and total>=45

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SBB's NFL O/U TREND:

The Steelers are 0-8 OU since Oct 28, 2007 the game before playing on Monday Night.

SDQL TEXT: *team=Steelers and n:day==Monday and date>=20071028*

SBB's NCAA O/U TREND:

Notre Dame is 0-9-1 OU since 2010 when the total is under 55 and they allowed no more than 12 points last game.

SDQL TEXT: *team=NOTD and po:points<=12 and total<55 and season>=2010*

SBB's NFL SUPER SYSTEM

Teams which lost at least 9 games last season and are away favorites in week one are 8-17 ATS. Active against KC and Tampa Bay.

SDQL TEXT: *week=1 and Sum(L@team and season)[team and season-1]>=9 and AF*

SBB's NCAA SUPER SYSTEM

Teams which have failed to cover vs. a conference team in at least their last five meetings are 249-203-5 ATS in database history. Active on Georgia.

SDQL TEXT: *P:ats margin<0 and PP:ats margin<0 and PPP:ats margin<0 and PPPP:ats margin<0 and PPPPP:ats margin<0 and conference=0:conference*

PICK SIXTY SPORTS WEEKLY TIP:

It's only fitting that the Seattle Seahawks open their season across the country against the Carolina Panthers. After all, Seattle travelled more miles than any other NFL team in 2012 and they have four starts scheduled for the Eastern Time zone this season. It's probably best to get one of them out of the way early.

Database history shows that overall, Seattle is just a .500 team (Over/Under) playing three time zones away but early in the season there is a heavy shift to lower scoring games:

team = Seahawks and A and o:time zone = E and day = Sunday and month = 9

The Hawks are 3-15-1 O/U in September road games in the East and with a total of 44 or greater, we like this game to stay under the number.

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Note: *It is not SportsBook Breakers recommendation to make plays based solely on one trend (our selections at killercappers.com don't). Weigh these trends along with other factors accordingly.*
