The Raptors are 12-0 OU (12.79 ppg) since Apr 14, 2002 at home with less than two days rest after they had at least ten blocks.

SDQL TEXT: team=Raptors and H and rest<2 and 10<=p:blocks and date>=20020414

SBB'S PLAYER TREND OF THE DAY:

The Raptors are 10-0 OU (16.10 ppg) since Jan 24, 2017 at home after a game as a home favorite in which Demar Derozan was the high scorer.

SDQL TEXT: team=Raptors and H and p:HF and Raptors:Demar Derozan:p:points=max:p:points and date>=20170124

SBB'S SDQL CHOICE TREND:

The Pacers are 0-11 ATS (-8.73 ppg) since Feb 16, 2017 as a dog with less than two days rest after they scored less than 15% of their points from free throws.

SDQL TEXT: team=Pacers and D and rest<2 and p:PFT<15 and date>=20170216
