THIS WEEKEND WITH SPORTSBOOK BREAKERS:

SPORTSBOOK BREAKERS NFL is coming off a Monday night win and has 4-STAR Sides going in each of Saturday's NFL Game. Get bot plays for \$20 in web debit value or purchase individually. Sunday's selections will be posted Sunday morning.

SPORTSBOOK BREAKERS NCAAFB has its 2014 bowl package, with at least an active trend/systems in all 39 games along with several full plays and bonus OU trends/systems, now available for \$149 in web debit value. Saturday, SBB has a 4.5-STAR, a 4-STAR Side, a trends play, and four more ATS systems active to span all five bowl games Get the one-day package for just \$25 in web debit value.



SBB'S NFL PLAY ON ATS TREND:

The Cardinals are 12-0-1 ATS (8.3 ppg) since October 30, 2011 when facing a team whose defense recorded 4-plus sacks in their last game.

SDQL TEXT: team=Cardinals and 4<=op:sacks and date>=20111030

SBB'S NFL PLAY AGAINST ATS TREND:

The Cowboys are 0-10 ATS (-11.4 ppg) since December 20, 2008 as a favorite when facing a team that has averaged at least 32 minutes of possession time season-to-date.

*SDQL TEXT: team=Cowboys and F and 32 * 60<=oA(TOP) and date>=20081220*

SBB'S NFL PLAYER TREND

Aaron Rodgers is 11-0 ATS (11.3 ppg) since November 2008 after a game where he threw more than two passes and completed no more than 56% of his attempts.

SDQL TEXT ARodgers:p:completions / ARodgers:p:passes<=.56 and ARodgers:p:passes>2 and date>=20081101

TB010: The Buccaneers are 0-8 ATS at home after road losses in each of their last two games.

SDQL TEXT: team=Buccaneers and H and p:AL and pp:AL and season>=1999

USER Submitted: Jay1: The Steelers are 0-12 ATS (-9.3 ppg) since 2005 as at least a three-point favorite when they play division rival Cincinnati next game.

SDQL TEXT: team=Steelers and line<-2.5 and no:team=Bengals and season>=2005

NFL BIBLE OUT TREND:

SEA011: The Seahawks are 16-0 OU versus any team with more wins after a win at home.

SDQL TEXT: team=Seahawks and p:HW and o:wins>wins and date>=19981201

SBB's NFL O/U OVER TREND:

The Rams are 13-0 OU (9.1 ppg) since October 9, 2005 at home when their ats margin decreased over each of their past two games and at least one of the last two games were against non-divisional opponents.

SDQL TEXT: team=Rams and H and p:ats margin<pp:ats margin<ppp:ats margin and (p:NDIV or pp:NDIV) and date>=20051009

SBB's NFL O/U UNDER TREND:

The Ravens are 0-10 OU (-11.7 ppg) since November 1, 2009 as a favorite of at least three points when their opponent's season-to-date average rushing attempts per game is greater than 30.

SDQL TEXT: team=Ravens and line<=-3 and 30<oA(rushes) and

SBB's NFL ATS SUPER SYSTEM

Teams that allowed fewer than 13 points last game and are more than five-point underdogs are 217-169-8 ATS. Active on Buffalo and Arizona.

SDQL TEXT: po:points<13 and line>5

SBB's NFL O/U SUPER SYSTEM

Teams that have thrown for at least three TDs in back-to-back games are 135-102-4 OU. Active on Dallas.

SDQL TEXT: p:PTD>=3 and pp:PTD>=3

PICK SIXTY SPORTS WEEKLY TIP:

Touchdown-plus road favorites get a bad rap in the NFL and from my perspective, they are more of a 'Wait and see' kind of game rather than a flat bet against the spread to begin with. The fact of the matter is that the most common road favorites, aka the "Usual Suspects", are only leading straight-up at the half 65-percent of the time anyway. The point is that if you like a team such as the Patriots, Packers or Ravens and they are laying points on the road, a third of the time you'll get a better line on them at half-time than the one that Joe Public is pounding all week before kickoff.

We covered this topic in detail a month ago at Pick Sixty Sports ("NFL Road Faves – The Six Best Bets") and with half of this week's NFL road teams favored, it seemed like a good time for a reminder. The other option for big road faves is to look at betting the total. Remember, not all road faves are created equal!

SDQL Text: AF and -14 <= line <= -6 and p:HFW and p:line <= -7 and week >= 4 and REG and NB

Entering this code displays a list of road faves between -6 and -14 points who are coming off home wins where they were also favored by at least a touchdown. The record for these teams is 74-98-3 ATS but we're more interested in the 64-percent hit rate on the total (110-62-3 O/U). This angle is "live" on three games this week: Lions at Bears (O/U 4.5), Pats at Jets (O/U 47.5) and Seahawks at Cardinals (O/U 36.5)

There are quarterback concerns in all three of these games but weather should not be an issue. For our money, the Pats' team total "Over" could be a better play than the full game but our top pick from these three is the NFC West battle. Arizona is perfect at home and they've been preparing for this game all year. Regardless of who is under center for the Cards, look for them to contribute enough to get this game over the low number.
