The League is 0-11 ATS (-8.3 ppg) since February 11, 2012 after a double digit road loss against the Pistons. Active against Boston.

SBB'S OU TREND OF THE DAY:

The Pistons are 11-0 OU (23.2 ppg) since January 02, 2009 with at least one day of rest off a win by less than 40 points in which their leading scorer for that game had fewer than 20 points.

SDQL TEXT: *team=Pistons and 0<rest and 0<p:margin<40 and max:tp:points<20 and 20090102<=date*

SBB'S PLAYER TREND OF THE DAY:

The Bucks are 0-14-2 OU (-10.3 ppg) since March 20, 2012 with at least a day of rest after a win in which Monta Ellis was not the Bucks' high scorer.

SDQL TEXT: *0<rest and p:W and Bucks:Monta Ellis:p:points<max:p:points and 20120320<=date*

SBB'S CHOICE TREND:

The Thunder are 0-14 OU (-13.0 ppg) since December 06, 2010 on the road when at least one team is rested after winning the previous matchup at home in which Kevin Durant had more turnovers than assists.

SDQL TEXT: *A and (rest>0 or o:rest>0) and P:HW and P:season=season and Thunder:Kevin Durant:P:assists<Thunder:Kevin Durant:P:turnovers and 20101206<=date*
