**4-Star Miami +20.5, Kansas City +4.5, Pittsburgh +4.5**

**Supporting Teaser-Specific Trends:** The Dolphins are 28-0 ATSP10 on grass off a game as a dog when they are playing a team with a better record. The Chiefs are 26-0 ATSP10 as a favorite when they are playing a team they beat earlier in the season. The Steelers are 25-0 ATSP10 at home when facing an opponent that is averaging less than five rushing first downs per game.

# MTi's NFL Selections / Week 17

## MTi's Newsletter Side Play

4-Star NY JETS +3.5 over Buffalo – The Jets were beaten badly by the Patriots last week and the Bulls lost in overtime against the Dolphins and both Ryans were fired. We have an active system that indicates the Jets are the play. NFL underdogs are 16-0 ATS on turf when not more than a week of rest when they are off a loss as a road dog by at least six points and they are facing a divisional opponent that had at least two fewer wins the previous regular season. The SDQL text is:

```
p:margin<=-6 and p:AD and D and surface = artificial and DIV and PRSW - o:PRSW>=2 and rest<=7 and date >= 20061200
```

In their last ten, these underdogs are 8-2 straight up. The last team in this spot was the Giants, when they upset the Cowboys 10-7 in week 14.

The Jets themselves are 7-0 ATS (+12.43 ppg) as a dog off a double-digit loss as a dog when facing a team that had fewer regular season wins the previous season. Nice!

As a team Buffalo is 0-9 ATS (-12.89 ppg) off a home loss as a favorite in which their opponent converted on at least five third downs. The SDQL text is:

```
team = Bills and p:LHF and po:3DM >= 5 and season >= 2005
```

Note that the Bills have had a difficult time scoring points in this spot, as they have averaged 9.2 ppg and were held to under TEN points in six of the nine games.

The Bills should be emotionally and physically drained after their overtime game vs the Dolphins last week. We expect that the Jets will be playing with more intensity. Grab the points.

## MTi's Newsletter Totals Play

4-Star NY Giants at Washington UNDER 44 – Washington was turnover-free in a 41-21 romp over the Bears, who had Matt Barkley at QB. Here they are a huge home favorite over the Giants. The Redskins are 0-8 OU (-8.44 ppg) as a favorite off a win as a favorite when facing a team that had fewer regular season wins the previous season.

The Redskins are also 0-11 OU at home vs a divisional opponent when it is after week ten and they are off a game in which they did not commit a turnover. The SDQL text is:

```
team = Redskins and H and DIV and p:TO=0 and week >= 10 and season >= 1992
```

The Redskins also qualify for a big system we have been following that had not lost since October this season. NFL teams that are laying at least a TD on grass and are off a game as a favorite are 4-29 OU vs a team that had fewer regular season wins in the previous season. The SDQL text is:

```
p:F and line <= -7 and surface = grass and PRSW > o:PRSW and date >= 20150111
```

The Giants have revenge here and they are 0-11 OU (-9.36 ppg) as a dog off a road game when they are playing a team they lost to earlier in the season.

Finally, the Giants are 0-8 OU (-12.81 ppg) as a road dog and after they had more third downs made than punts.

The SDQL text is:

```
team = Giants and AD and p:3DM > p:punts and date >= 20120122
```

# SportsBook Breakers' NFL Selections / Week 17

## SBB's Top Newsletter Side

4-STAR MIAMI over New England – While New England will be playing to win this game, they've gotten to the point where they are not going to need to show too much here to pick up that victory. Look for these teams to both come out with bland game plans while looking forward, leading to a tight, close game.

New England has the possibly of closing out the rare feat of going 8-0 on the road this year, but that kind of success away from home is difficult to maintain. Teams playing their final regular season away game which have won at least six of their first seven away games are 15-28-2 ATS (tS(1@A) = 7 and A and tS(W@A)>=6).

Miami meanwhile has gone a strong 6-1 at home this season and that is easier to continue to replicate. Teams playing their final regular season home game which have won at least six of their first seven home games are 95-74-2 ATS (tS(1@H) = 7 and H and tS(W@H)>=6).

And for the perception of these teams given the line, Miami is only three games behind New England in the standings at 10-5. In week 17, teams which have between 1 and 3 wins fewer than their opponent are 122-67-4 ATS (week=17 and -3<=wins-o:wins<=-1).

Yet despite that not so large gap in the standings, they are getting double digit points at home. Teams which are more than 7 point home dogs are 184-150-1 ATS (H and line>7).

Late in the season, all home dogs tend to be value plays. Teams as home dogs in weeks 15-17 are 220-171-14 ATS (HD and 17>=week>=15).

New England is coming off a super easy 41-3 win over the Jets. New York handed them four turnovers in the game. The Patriots are 0-7 ATS (-6.07 ppg) since Dec 23, 2012 on the road off a game as a home favorite where they forced at least two turnovers (team=Patriots and A and po:turnovers>=2 and p:HF and date>=20121223).

Miami meanwhile is coming off a hard fought, important 34-31 overtime win in Buffalo last week. The 34 points were 14.5 more than expected. The Dolphins are 9-0 ATS (9.61 ppg) since Sep 15, 2013 coming off a road win where they scored more than expected (team=Dolphins and p:dps>0 and p:AW and date>=20130915).

They overcame really getting ravished on the ground by

Buffalo who picked up 272 rushing yards in the loss. The Dolphins are 7-0-1 ATS (8.56 ppg) since Nov 25, 2012 as a home dog when rushing for at least 100 yards last game (team=Dolphins and HD and po:rushing yards>=100 and date>=20121125)

4-STAR Carolina over TAMPA BAY – Because of how these teams seasons have gone, there is a perception that Tampa Bay has been much better, but that's mainly because of when in the season these teams have been eliminated in the season. In reality, these are not very different teams at all and you are getting free points here.

Tampa Bay currently sits at 8-7 while Carolina is 6-9. In week 17, teams which have between 1 and 3 wins fewer than their opponent are 122-67-4 ATS (week=17 and -3<=wins-o:wins<=-1).

It has been very hit or miss for Carolina down the stretch with the Panthers rolling over against Atlanta last week in a 33-16 loss. The Panthers are 8-0 ATS (7.38 ppg) since Dec 02, 2001 vs a divisional opponent and off a home loss in which they never led (team = Panthers and p:H and DIV and p:L and p:BL = 0 and date >= 20011202).

For Tampa Bay, this is a return home after two devastating road losses. The Buccaneers are 0-9 ATS (-11.78 ppg) since Oct 24, 1999 when they are at home after two away losses (team = Buccaneers and H and p:AL and pp:AL and date >= 19991024).

It was their defense that let them down last week in a 31-24 loss to New Orleans. The Buccaneers are 0-7 ATS (-13.71 ppg) since Sep 27, 2009 at home off a game as a road dog of more than three points where they allowed at least 30 points (team=Buccaneers and H and po:points>=30 and p:A and 3<p:line and date>=20090927).

That game was expected to be a high scorer with a total of 53 but the total in this game is a TD lower. Teams which saw its total drop by at least 6.5 points from last game are 368-480-22 ATS (total-p:total<=-6.5).

SPORTSBOOK BREAKERS PREDICTION: Carolina 24, TAMPA BAY 21

**PLAY ON: In week 17, teams which have between 1 and 3 wins fewer than their opponent**

**122-67-4 ATS (2.68, 64.6%)**

**SDQL TEXT: week=17 and -3<=wins-o:wins<=-1**



For most of the season, the construct of how teams are going to play, their motivations, and what to look for are the same. However week 17 of the NFL season is a completely different animal. Motivations change completely depending on if a team is in the playoffs, out of the playoffs or still playing for something. But those motivations can go the other way and be overcompensated in lines. This is one of those spots where we see a teams motivation and their game results being overrated.

System: In week 17, teams which have between 1 and 3 wins fewer than their opponent are 122-67-4 ATS.

What we see here is a spot where the better team throughout the season is being overrated. There can be two reasons for this. One is that the difference in wins is giving the better team "something to play for" while the team with the worse record does not. The other is that the team with more wins is just be valued higher although the difference between having 1-3 more wins over the course is not a huge difference. Yet these teams with the lower record are an average of +1.9 point underdogs in week 17.

In week 17, this system is active on eight teams: Cincinnati, Carolina, Miami, New Orleans, New York, Los Angeles, Washington and Tennessee. Consider playing on those teams.

# Pick Sixty Sports: Tips and Totals

There are always a lot of question marks in the final week of the NFL season. The fact that every game is divisional ensures a wholehearted effort from most of the players on the field, but coaches and management will decide which of those players are on the field and for how long. Starters for a team like Dallas could easily be given a rest in the second-half against Philly, just like backups in Cleveland could dominate against Pittsburgh.

In the case of Buffalo, Jacksonville and Los Angeles, management is probably playing more of a role in terms of setting the Week 17 active roster but these are not the only three teams that will be looking for a new head coach a week from today. The top brass needs to know what they're sitting on as they chart their course towards the 2017 draft, regardless of who is coaching the team.

Options for the handicapper include:

A. Shortening your card; perhaps only focusing on the games where both teams are clearly motivated (ie. Packers at Lions).

B. Reducing your wager amount; simply cutting the size a normal unit in half to reduce exposure.

C. Create new techniques with the SDQL that are dedicated towards real, late-season situations that teams are facing today.

Here is an example for the Kansas City Chiefs (11-4) at San Diego Chargers (5-10). The road team is clearly motivated for a win here, knowing they could earn a first round bye if it came down to a tie breaker with Oakland (12-3). Coach Andy Reid and his team can't be concerned about the Raiders' odds for beating Denver, but are the Chiefs are good bet laying -5.5 or -6 points in San Diego?

Divisional road faves beyond Week 13 are slightly overvalued the past few years, going 17-21 ATS. But what stands out with this code is the 12-25-1 O/U record. That's a 67.6% record for the under and you will note that it's "live" in six games this weekend:

SDQL: DIV and AF and week > 13 and season > 2012

This setup for divisional road faves like the Chiefs up to -7 points off a home game in Week 16 or 17 shows a strong straight-up record and only 6-11-3 ATS. 10-point teasers on the road fave are 18-2 so perhaps the idea of teasing Kansas City is better than flat betting them on a number that has already moved a point and-a-half since opening.

SDQL: DIV and AF and week > 15 and p:H and wins > 10 and REG and line >= -7

In this game or any other Week 17 matchup, consider what happened in the first meeting. Sticking with this example, the Chiefs beat the Chargers 33-27 in overtime, Week 1, after trailing 21-3 at the half. That game was the first of eight games this year that San Diego would lose by seven points or less. The record for divisional home dogs that lost earlier in the year in overtime is 10-4-1 ATS with 6 overs and 9 unders.

SDQL: HD and P:L and P:OT = 1 and P:season = season

In games that took place beyond Week 13, the dog is 5-1 ATS and five of six games stayed under. Also note that dogs getting more than a field goal in this situation are 8-1 ATS, seen here.

SDQL: HD and P:L and P:OT = 1 and P:season = season and DIV and line > 3

We mentioned how many close calls the Chargers had this season and there is a way of researching this with SDQL. The record for dogs at this stage of the season that have suffered eight or more losses by a TD or less is 8-3 SU and 9-2 ATS. Access the information with this code and note that the four teams in their final home game went 1-3 O/U with all three unders hitting by double-digits.

SDQL: tS(-7<=margin<0) > 7 and week > 16 and D and REG

Finally, we don't want to lose sight of the fact that Kansas City are playing their first road game in nearly a month. The overall record for road teams in this spot is 28-49 O/U and divisional games lean further to the low side at 6-13 O/U (68.4% UNDER).

SDQL: A and site streak > 2 and season > 2008 and REG and DIV

Phil Rivers threw for 321 yards last week and I'm sure he and his old buddy Antonio Gates would like to finish strong but there is a reason why this team is 5-10. Rivers is 2-12 O/U at home with divisional revenge and 5-15 O/U following his past 20 games with 300-plus passing yards.

SDQL: Chargers:Phil Rivers:PY > 0 and p:PY > 300 and season > 2012

That record includes a 3-7 ATS mark at home with 2 overs and 8 unders. The record for any home team this late in the season with less than six wins who are coming off a 300-yard passing game where they lost away from home is 5-11-1 O/U (SDQL: p:PY >= 300 and p:AL and H and NB and week > 14 and wins < 6) and this total is available right now at 44.5 points.

Pick No. 1: Take the Chiefs and Chargers UNDER 44.5 points

The Bengals are 8-0 ATS (9.06 ppg) since Sep 22, 2013 at home when their opponent allowed more than 400 total yards in their last game. The Bengals are 8-0-2 ATS (5.55 ppg) since Dec 16, 2001 off a loss where their defense achieved 4+ sacks. The Ravens are 0-9 OU (-4.72 ppg) since Oct 05, 2008 as a dog off a game as a dog where they had more than 34 minutes of possession time. The Bengals are 0-7 OU (-8.71 ppg) since Oct 22, 2006 at home as a favorite after a loss in which they were leading at the half.

Raiders at Broncos - The Raiders are 0-9 ATS (-12.33 ppg) since Dec 27, 2009 as a dog off a win where they rushed for at least 50 yards more than their average. The Raiders are 8-0 ATS (6.12 ppg) since Nov 29, 2015 on the road. The Broncos are 0-7-1 ATS (-6.19 ppg) since Dec 24, 1994 at home off a road game where they suffered a 21+ point loss. The Raiders are 0-8 OU (-8.44 ppg) since Jan 19, 2002 on the road off a game as a favorite where they had zero turnovers. The Broncos are 0-6 OU (-7.00 ppg) since Nov 22, 2015 as a favorite after a game in which they did not have a 50-plus yard rusher.

Panthers at Buccaneers - The Panthers are 0-8 ATS (-12.56 ppg) since Sep 15, 2013 off a home loss. The Buccaneers are 7-0 ATS (8.00 ppg) since Sep 14, 2008 as a favorite vs a divisional opponent off a game as a dog. The Panthers are 10-0-1 OU (9.82 ppg) since Sep 30, 2012 on the road after a loss and ATS loss. The Panthers are 7-0-1 OU (10.88 ppg) since Sep 15, 2013 on the road off a loss where they had at least two turnovers. The Panthers are 6-0 OU (17.58 ppg) since Nov 14, 2004 on the road on grass off a loss in which they never led. The Buccaneers are 0-8 OU (-5.81 ppg) since Nov 09, 2014 vs a divisional opponent that is averaging at least 35 passes per game.

Chiefs at Chargers - The Chiefs are 0-6 ATS (-4.67 ppg) since Dec 13, 2015 after a loss in which they were outscored by at least 10 in the second half. The Chiefs are 0-6 ATS (-6.75 ppg) since Dec 13, 2015 off a 10+ point win. The Chargers are 7-0 ATS (11.36 ppg) since Oct 10, 1999 off a game as a favorite after they had less than 50 rushing yards. The Chiefs are 0-9 OU (-7.89 ppg) since Dec 27, 2015 as a favorite coming off a win. The Chargers are 0-7 OU (-13.64 ppg) since Jan 02, 2005

at home as a dog vs a divisional opponent.

Jaguars at Colts - The Jaguars are 0-7 ATS (-14.50 ppg) since Dec 30, 2007 as a dog off a 10+ point win. The Colts are 6-0 ATS (11.00 ppg) since Dec 27, 2015 off a loss where they were outgained by their opponent. The Jaguars are 0-6-1 OU (-7.29 ppg) since Jan 07, 2006 on the road when their ATS margin increased over their past 3 games.
