### SBB'S SDQL CHOICE TREND:

The Magic are 11-0 OU (14.00 ppg) since Feb 01, 2008 on the road after they had at least ten more turnovers than their opponent.

**SDQL TEXT:** *team=Magic and A and po:TO + 10<=p:TO and date>=20080201*
