THIS WEEKEND WITH SPORTSBOOK BREAKERS:

SPORTSBOOK BREAKERS NCAA has eight plays Saturday, led by two huge 5-STAR plays with its Side of the Year and its Upset Special of the Year. SBB also have a 4.5-STAR Side, five 4-STAR Sides and five trends plays Saturday. Get all that in its Saturday package for just \$49 in web debit value.



SPORTSBOOK BREAKERS NFL won its top play, going 1-2 Thursday, and will return Saturday with its full selection of quality Sunday picks.

SBB's NFL PLAY ON ATS TREND:

The Chargers are 10-0 ATS (14.55 ppg) since Oct 14, 2007 at home when one game under 500.

SDQL TEXT: team=Chargers and H and wins+1=losses and date>=20071014

SBB's NFL PLAY AGAINST TREND:

The Titans are 0-11 ATS (-8.82 ppg) since Dec 19, 2004 after a game in which they had at least 300 yards passing.

SDQL TEXT: team=Titans and 300<=p:PY and date>=20041219

SBB's TOP NFL PLAYER TREND:

Carson Palmer is 0-8 ATS (-14.44 ppg) since December 2011 as more than a two-point dog when he threw for between 205 and 370 yards last week.

SDQL TEXT: 370>=Carson Palmer:p:passing yards>=205 and line>2 and date>=20111201

NFL BIBLE ACTIVE TREND:

The Chiefs are 0-17-2 OU (-9.3 ppg) since January 2005 when the total in the game is at least 47.

SDQL TEXT: team = Chiefs and date>=20050101 and total >= 47

SBB's NCAA PLAY ON ATS TREND:

Ohio St. is 15-0 ATS (9.0 ppg) since October 29, 2005 as a favorite of more than four points past game two of the season, when they won by between 22 and 42 last game while scoring less than 60 points.

SDQL TEXT: team=OHST and date>=20051029 and 22<=p:margin<=42 and line<-4 and game number>2 and

SBB's NCAA PLAY AGAINST TREND:

Colorado St. is 0-13 ATS (-14.8 ppg) since October 2006 with a total under 62, if they lost by between 4 and 18 last game while allowing less than 45 points and it wasn't at a neutral site.

SDQL TEXT: team=COST and date>=20061001 and -18<=p:margin<=-4 and total<62 and p:site!=neutral and po:points<45

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SBB's NFLO/UTREND:

The Panthers are 0-12 OU (-8.21 ppg) since Dec 12, 2004 as a home favorite when they have had a negative dpa in each of their last two games.

SDQL TEXT: team=Panthers and HF and p:dpa<0 and pp:dpa<0 and date>=20041212

SBB's NCAA O/UTREND:

Florida State is 10-0 OU (16.9 ppg) since October 2007 in games where the total is 44 or under.

SDQL TEXT: team=FLST and total<=44 and date>=20071001

SBB's NFL SUPER SYSTEM

Teams that scored at least 27 points while gaining less than 255 yards last game are 79-52-7 OU. Active on Cincinnati.

SDQL TEXT: p:points>=27 and p:TY<255

SBB's NCAA SUPER SYSTEM

Teams which went under by at least 15 points in each of the past two games are 138-114-8 ATS. Active on Vanderbilt.

SDQL TEXT: p:ou margin<=-15 and pp:ou margin<=-15

PICK SIXTYSPORTS WEEKLY TIP:

The playoff picture is slowly starting to take shape as we flip the calendars to December and following Dallas' win over the Raiders, Sunday night's game between the New York Giants and Washington Redskins essentially becomes an elimination game. Washington was already manhandled by the 49ers in the first of its three-game home stand and if they even want anyone to show up for next week's game against the Chiefs, the Skins better learn to play some defense and quick!

The Giants followed their Week 9 bye with three consecutive home games and they won the first two before getting swept in the season series vs. the Cowboys in Week 12. So far this season, teams who travel after an extended home stand are 2-4 SU, 3-3 ATS and 1-5 O/U. The longterm look-back (since 1989) shows a 50-percent record ATS with a slight lean to the under (55-percent) and the more recent record for totals is 27-46 O/U (63-percent UN).

SDQL: A and site streak = 3 and season >= 2008 and REG and total >= 44 and -10 < line < 10

Totals of 44 or more resulted in 6 overs and 18 unders the past six years and when the ATS line is single-digits, either way, that mark reduces to 3-18 O/U (85-percent UN). The Sunday night total is available at 46.5 and for this week's tip we are taking the Giants and Redskins UNDER.

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Note: It is not SportsBook Breakers recommendation to make plays based solely on one trend (our selections at killercappers.com don't). Weigh these trends along with other factors accordingly.
