SBB's NFL PLAY ON ATS TREND:

The Eagles are 11-0 ATS (10.5 ppg) since 1991 as a road dog after scoring 34+ points.

SDQL TEXT: team=Eagles and AD and 34<=p:points and season>=1991

SBB's NCAA PLAY ON ATS TREND:

BYU is 11-0 ATS (11.3 ppg) since November 21, 2009 with the total under 65 after a game as a road favorite

SDQL TEXT: team=BYU and total<65 and p:AF and date>=20091121

SBB's NFL PLAY AGAINST TREND:

The 49ers are 0-11-1 ATS (-11.1 ppg) since 2003 when they are off a game in which they led by at least a TD after the first quarter, but allowed 20-plus points.

SDQL TEXT: team=49ers and p:M1>=7 and po:points>=20 and season>=2003

SBB's NCAA PLAY AGAINST TREND:

Army is 0-10 ATS (-11.7 ppg) since November 19, 2011 as a road dog.

SDQL TEXT: team=ARMY and AD and date>=20111119

SBB's TOP NFL PLAYER TREND:

The Bears are 0-8-1 ATS (-6.6 ppg) since October 28, 2012 at home after a game in which Brandon Marshall had at least 6 receptions.

SDQL TEXT: H and 6<=Bears:Brandon Marshall:p:receptions and date>=20121028

SBB'S NFL O/UTREND:

The Eagles are 0-16 OU (-10.8 ppg) since December 25, 2006 when they scored more than 15 points more than expected last game.

SDQL TEXT: team=Eagles and date>=20061225 and p:dps>15

SBB'S NFL SUPER SYSTEM

Teams coming off a win as more than a three-point dog where they forced at least four turnovers are 105-145-4 OU. Active on Cleveland.

SDQL TEXT: po:turnovers>=4 and p:line>3 and p:W

PICK SIXTY SPORTS WEEKLY TIP:

The Minnesota Vikings return from a bye week Sunday to face a Chicago Bears team who off one of the most humiliating losses in recent memory. The old saying is that no team will be as bad/good as they looked the previous week and in the Bears case, it should be true. After all, how could a team get any worse? The Bears are the first team in database history to allow 50-plus points one game after allowing 50-plus points (SDQL Text: po:points>48 and ppo:points>49).

Good news for the Bears defense is that they don't have to face another round of discount double-checks and this Minnesota offense is almost as bad as Green Bay's is good. As far as sides go, we don't feel particularly good about backing either of these teams but we have a couple angles supporting a play on the total.

SDQL: ppp:TOP < pp:TOP < p:TOP and streak <= -3 and season >= 1996 and 38 <= total <= 51 and 6 <= rest <= 7 and site != p:site and DIV

The Bears have improved their time of possession from 22:38 (MIA) to 27:17 (NE) to 30:19 (GB) but still lost all three. Look for a gameplan this week that tries to limit the Vikings offensive chances. This team is rattled right now and the fear of making mistakes could end up hurting them again. Divisional home teams in this spot are only 9-29 SU and 13-23-2 ATS, getting outscored 24-17 and staying under at a rate of 70-percent (11-26-1 O/U). When the line for divisional games was within +/-3 points of 'Pick' the record since 1996 is 2-16 O/U. For 10 cents, consider buying the hook up to '47'.

Take the Vikings and Bears UNDER 47 (-120)

Ohio State is 11-0 OU (15.4 ppg) since 2007 when the total is over 46 and they are not playing Michigan, coming off a win where they were not double digit favorites.

SDQL TEXT: team=OHST and season>=2007 and p:W and p:line>-10 and total>46 and o:team!=MICH

SBB'S NCAA SUPER SYSTEM

Teams that led by more than a point after one quarter and lost by more than 14 last game are 117-156-4 ATS. Active against Utah.

SDQL TEXT: p:margin after the first>1 and p:margin<-14
