SBB's NFL PLAY ON ATS TREND:

The Patriots are 13-0 ATS (12.65 ppg) since November 3, 2002 within 3 of pick after a loss.

SDQL TEXT: team=Patriots and -3<=line<=3 and p:L and date>=20021103

SBB's NFL PLAY AGAINST TREND:

The Lions are 0-10 ATS (-7.40 ppg) since Nov 06, 2005 on artificial turf after a loss as a favorite

SDQL TEXT: team=Lions and surface=artificial and p:FL and NB and date>=20051106

SBB's TOP NFL PLAYER TREND:

Andrew Luck is 12-0 ATS (8.9 ppg) in his career after a game where he threw between 35 and 50 passes and completed over 45% of them.

SDQL TEXT: 50>=Andrew Luck:p:passes>=35 and Andrew Luck:p:completions/Andrew Luck:p:passes>.45

NFL BIBLE ACTIVE TREND:

The Raiders are 0-14-1 ATS (-9.9 ppg) since October 13, 2002 after a game where they covered by more than six points and allowed at least 21 points.

SDQL TEXT: team=Raiders and p:ats margin>6 and 21<=po:points and 20021013<=date

SBB's NCAA PLAY ON ATS TREND:

Arizona is 11-0-1 ATS (14.0 ppg) since November 2004 as a home dog if they did not lose by 20+ last game and allowed at least 10 points.

SDQL TEXT: team=ARZ and HD and date>=20041101 and p:margin>-20 and po:points>=10

SBB's NCAA PLAY AGAINST TREND:

Georgia is 0-15 ATS (-9.2 ppg) since 2006 in the regular season if they lost by more than a field goal last game and either won two games ago or it was the first game of the year

SDQL TEXT: team=GEO and game type=RS and p:margin<=-4 and season>=2006 and (p:game number=1 or pp:margin>0)

The Chargers are 0-10 OU (-11.05 ppg) since December 08, 2002 as a dog after a game in which they sacked the opposing quarterback at least 4 times.

SDQL TEXT: team=Chargers and D and 4<=p:sacks and NB and date>=20021208

SBB's NFL SUPER SYSTEM

Teams which have covered in at least six straight games are 37-47-1 ATS. Active on Carolina.

SDQL TEXT: ats streak>=6

PICK SIXTY SPORTS WEEKLY TIP:

The goal for this time next week is a big belly full of leftovers and an even fatter bankroll from the three Thanksgiving NFL games. But first we have to get through Week 12 and for the Detroit Lions; one of the annual challenges is to make sure they don't get caught looking ahead to the Turkey Day festivities. Detroit has had a losing record 17 of the past 24 years heading into their pre-Thanksgiving Day matchup so maybe the only thing they were looking forward to was the 10-day holiday break but either way, the Lions went 5-12 SU and scored just 19.2 points per game (PPG).

The seven teams with .500 or better records were still only 3-4 SU/ATS but their scoring increased to 24 PPG including a 49-point effort as a 7-point home favorite against the Panthers in 2011.

SDQL: team = Lions and n:H and day = Sunday and n:day = Thursday and month = 11 and t:WP >= 50

In three pre-Turkey Day games as a favorite the Lions have scored 32, 38 and 49 points (39.7 PPG) and we certainly feel this year's edition is capable of marching into the 30's. Tampa Bay also has 20-plus points scored in five of their past six and it was Carolina's D who kept them quiet. Look for a solid effort from both sides as this game goes OVER 48.5 points.

SBB's NCAA O/UTREND:

Indiana is 15-0 OU (18.3 ppg) since November 22, 2008 as at least a four-point dog when they did not lose by more than 14 last time they faced this team.

SDQL TEXT: team=IND and date>=20081122 and line>=4 and P:margin>=-14

SBB's NCAA SUPER SYSTEM

Teams which are favored by at least 19 points at home after losing at least two straight games are 126-94-5 ATS. Active on Miami and Florida.

SDQL TEXT: p:L and pp:L and line<=-19 and H
