The Cowboys are 11-0 ATS (11.9 ppg) since 2000 on the road as a dog vs an opponent that allows a completion rate of more than 65 percent.

SDQL TEXT: team=Cowboys and AD and oA(o:CP)>=65 and season>=2000

SBB's NCAA PLAY ON ATS TREND:

Western Michigan is 10-0 ATS (15.5 ppg) since September 13, 2014 after a game where they had at least 400 yards total offense.

SDQL TEXT: team=WMCH and p:passing yards + p:rushing yards>=400 and date>=20140913

SBB's NFL PLAY AGAINST TREND:

The Lions are 0-12 ATS (-5.4 ppg) since November 24, 2011 after a game where they allowed at least seven points more than expected.

SDQL TEXT: team=Lions and p:dpa>=7 and date>=20111124

SBB's NCAA PLAY AGAINST TREND:

Uconn is 0-10 ATS (-7.0 ppg) since October 19, 2012 after a home game where they scored less than 21 points.

SDQL TEXT: team=CON and p:points<21 and p:H and date>=20121019

SBB's TOP NFL PLAYER TREND:

The Dolphins are 0-7 ATS (-14.0 ppg) since December 2014 coming off a game where Ryan Tannehill completed at least 60% of his passes.

SDQL TEXT: Ryan Tannehill:p:completions / Ryan Tannehill:p:passes>=.60 and date>=20141201

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SBB's NFL O/U OVER TREND:

The Patriots are 11-0 OU (6.3 ppg) since December 2010 at home after throwing for at least 300 yards as a road favorite.

SDQL TEXT: team=Patriots and H and p:passing yards>=300 and p:AF and date>=20101201

SBB's NFL O/U UNDER TREND:

The Colts are 0-11 OU (-12.1 ppg) since 2006 as a favorite after a loss as an underdog where they allowed more points than expected.

SDQL TEXT: team=Colts and F and p:dpa>0 and p:DL and date>=20060101

NFL BIBLE ACTIVE TREND:

NE011: The Patriots are 16-0 OU when hosting a team that has averaged more than 6 rushing first downs per game.

SDQL TEXT: team=Patriots and H and oA(RFD)>6 and date>=20101031

SBB's NCAA O/U OVER TREND:

Baylor is 10-0 OU (15.0 ppg) since October 16, 2010 as a favorite after a game where they did not turn over the ball.

SDQL TEXT: team=BAY and F and p:turnovers=0 and date>=20101016

SBB's NCAA O/U UNDER TREND:

Alabama is 0-10-1 OU (-8.7 ppg) since October 18, 2008 at home after picking up no more than 18 first downs last game.

SDQL TEXT: team=ALA and H and p:first downs<=18 and date>=20081018

SBB's NFL DFS STAT OF THE WEEK:

Philip Rivers put up a monster day throwing the ball last week with over 500 yards through the air. Factoring in sacks, San Diego threw for 488 yards in the game. There are 33 instances in database history of teams throwing for over 450 yards and in the following week, those teams threw for 43 yards more than the average team (256 vs. 213) and have hurled 2.3 touchdowns per game. Consider riding Rivers hot streak this week.

SDQL TEXT: p:PY>=450 and PY
