**Supporting Teaser-Specific Trends:** The Bears are 28-0 ATSp10 off a road game in which one player had at least 75% of their rushing yards. The Rams are 24-0 ATSp10 and as a dog off a game as a favorite and vs a team that had more regular season wins the previous season. The Steelers are 24-0 ATSp10 off a game as a favorite at home vs a divisional opponent that has a season-to-date average third down conversion percentage of less than 40%.

# MTi's NFL Selections / Week 2

## MTi's Newsletter Side Play

4-Star Kansas City +2.5 over HOUSTON - The Chiefs mounted an amazing comeback against the Chargers last week to win 33-27 in overtime. They have to be brimming with confidence and primed to get to 2-0.

The Chiefs had 26 first downs and were 2 for 2 on fourth down and they are 9-0 ATS after a home win in which they converted at least five third downs. The SDQL is:

```
team = Chiefs and p:HW and p:3DM >= 5 and date >= 20131103
```

Running the SDQL text reveals that the Chiefs are 5-0 ATS since the start of the 2015 season, winning every game by AT LEAST 14 points.

The Texans do have a tough defense, but the Chiefs are 10-0 ATS on the road vs a non-divisional opponent that has forced an average of at least six punts per game. The SDQL for this one is:

```
team = Chiefs and A and NDIV and 6 <= oA(o:punts) and season >= 2000
```

The Chiefs also match up well vs rushing teams, going 9-0 ATS on the road on grass and facing a team that is averaging at least 30 rushes per game. Check it out with this SDQL text:

```
team = Chiefs and A and surface = grass and 30 <= oA(rushes) and season >= 2011
```

Shifting our focus to the Texans, we find that they are 0-7 ATS at home when the line is within three of pick on grass vs a non-divisional opponent when they are off a game in which they outgained their opponent. The SDQL text is:

```
team = Texans and H and -3<=line<=3 and surface = grass and NDIV and p:TY>po:TY and season >= 2010
```

Houston was outscored by an average of 13.71 ppg in this spot. We are on the Chiefs.

## MTi's Newsletter Totals Play

3-Star Tampa Bay at Arizona UNDER 50 -- The Cardinals converted 50% of their third down attempts vs the Patriots, but they still lost 23-21. We are on the UNDER here. Arizona is 0-8 OU at home off a home loss in which they converted at least five third downs, allowing an average of only 13.4 ppg.

Also, the Cardinals are 0-7 at home off a SU and ATS loss as a favorite.

The Buccaneers have some compelling UNDER indicators working here. The Cardinals had fourteen first downs through the air vs New England in week one and Tampa is 0-18 OU on grass during the regular season when they are off a road game and facing a team that has averaged 13-plus passing first downs per game. The SDQL text is:

```
team = Buccaneers and surface = grass and REG and p:A and oA(PFD) >= 13
```

As you can see, the Bucs played two games in this spot last season and they held both opponents to under 20 points.

Since the start of the 2015 NFL season, the Cardinals have been a favorite by more than a TD four times. All four stayed UNDER and all four had OU lines that were less than this one. Make the play the UNDER.

# SportsBook Breakers' NFL Selections / Week 2

## SBB's Newsletter Side

4.5-STAR Jacksonville over SAN DIEGO – While both these teams started the season 0-1, they got there in very different ways. The Jaguars fought hard the entire way against one of the best teams in the league, coming up short in the final minute. San Diego meanwhile blew a devastating lead and lost their best player for the season. The Chargers don't deserve the home field advantage they are getting here.

Neither of these teams had a successful 2015, with Jacksonville going 5-11. In the first four week of the season, teams that are road dogs of less than a TD that won less than seven games last season are 135-73-9 ATS (week<=4 and tpS(W)<7 and 6.5>=line>0 and A).

San Diego was a large road dog in week one at Kansas City and are now home favorites here. Team which have a line in week two and least eight points lower than in week one are 48-66-4 ATS (H and p:overtime=1 and p:AL and NB).

The Chargers went to overtime last week, losing in KC 33-27. Teams at home after an overtime loss on the road last week are 48-66-4 ATS (H and p:overtime=1 and p:AL and NB).

After a strong first half, their defense fell apart down the stretch. The Chargers are 0-13-1 ats since Nov 25, 2012 when they allowed at least 24 points as a road dog last game (team=Chargers and po:points>=24 and p:AD and date>=20121125).

With a total of 45, that game went over the total by 15 points. The Chargers are 0-8 ats since Oct 19, 2009 off a road game where they went over the total by at least 14 points (team=Chargers and p:ou margin>=14 and p:A and date>=20091019).

As Kansas City overcame a 21-3 deficit they took to the air with great success. They threw for 330 yards. The Chargers are 0-9 ats since Oct 19, 2009 at home after allowing at least 300+ passing yards last game (team=Chargers and H and po:passing yards>=300 and date>=20091019).

On the other side, Philip Rivers had great success in through the air going 25-of-36. The Chargers are 0-10 ats since Oct 19, 2014 at home after a game where Philip Rivers completed at least 60% of his passes (H and Philip Rivers:p:completions / Philip Rivers:p:passes>=.60 and date>=20141019).

## SportsBook Breakers' Total Play

4-STAR Atlanta and Oakland Under – Both these teams are coming off week one shootouts but those were more dictated by game flow after each fell behind multiple scores playing indoors. In what should be a much closer game throughout, look for the defenses to play better here.

Atlanta is the underdog traveling to Oakland in this game. The Falcons are 0-8 ou since Dec 14, 2014 as a dog (team = Falcons and D and date >= 20141214).

They are coming off a 31-24 week one loss to Tampa Bay. The Falcons are 0-8 ou since Oct 19, 2014 on the road coming off a loss (team = Falcons and A and p:L and date >= 20141019).

Oakland won an even higher scoring game last week, 35-34. Teams which won a game in which they allowed at least 28 points last game are 206-263-10 OU (po:points>=28 and p:W).

They got a huge fourth quarter run from Jalen Richard who scampered 75 yards for a rare long rushing TD. Teams which had a rush of at least 70 yards last game are 48-74-5 OU (max:p:longest rush>70).

However both teams still did the bulk of their work through the air. Oakland allowed Drew Brees and the Saints to compile 419 passing yards. The Raiders are 0-6-1 ou since Oct 13, 2002 as a favorite vs a non-divisional opponent and after they allowed at least 300 yards passing last game (team = Raiders and F and N DIV and 300 <= po:PY and date >= 20021013).

**PLAY AGAINST: Teams which have a line in week two more than eight points lower than in week one**

**48-66-4 ATS (-2.07, 42.1%)**

**SDQL TEXT: week=2 and line-p:line<-8**



The NFL is a league where bettors overreact more than any other sport. There are only a limited number of opportunities to see teams and a limited number of sample sizes with the results. And there is no time where overreactions happen more than week two of the season. This is one of those spots.

Teams which have a line in week two more than eight points lower than in week one are 48-66-4 ATS (-2.07, 42.1%).

A big line swing in one direction after one week is somewhat unusual. And it is important to remember that just one week into the season, there are three likely potential causes for this. A better than expected performance from this team in week one, a worse than expected performance from this team's opponent in week one, or an opponent that is simply much, much worse than the one that they played last week.

This system works exactly as you'd expect. When the line jumps far in a team's favor between week one and week two, their performance does not meet expectations. And when a team's line drops significantly from week one to week two, performance exceeds the decreased expectations.

This week, the system is currently active on five teams, spanning all three scenarios. Consider fading Denver, San Diego, Carolina, New England and Chicago this week.

# Cajun Sports College Football System

Play ON a non-conference underdog of 8½-21½ points off a home SU win as an underdog of 11+ points vs. an opponent not off a home favorite SU loss.

## System Analysis

We knew last weekend's college card would be hard pressed to match the opening weekend's level of anticipation and outcome for the most part and we were right. Although for those of us that love college football and pro football we still watched and would have it no other way.

A few surprises from Week #2 of the college season as the Tigers of Clemson struggled against the Trojans of Troy University. The Trojans did return sixteen starters from a year ago which last season would be considered a rebuilding year but they did improve even through the course of the season. So it shouldn't come as a huge surprise that the Trojans are a better team but the oddsmakers certainly didn't give them any respect.

The Tigers eventually won 30 to 24 as 36.5-point home favorites but they were not impressive and showing signs of possible trouble down the road. The Tigers did lose eight on the defensive side of the ball from last season's team but there should have been some depth there as they were the fifth youngest team in the FBS playing twenty-eight freshmen during the 2015-16 season.

The oddsmakers opened Clemson as 34-point home favorites and the squares bet them up to as much as 36.5-point favorites by the time the game went off. It will be interesting to watch what happens to the Tigers this season after dropping a heartbreaker in the championship game to Alabama.

Another game that was a little surprising to a couple of my friends they believed TCU would crush Arkansas at home last week. They were right in line with the squares on that one also with TCU opening at 4-point home favorites and they were bet up to as much as 7.5-point favorites by kickoff. In this contest TCU didn't even win much less cover the spread losing to the Razorbacks 41 to 38. It could be a long season for Horned Frog backers who have been out front the last few years claiming they

get no respect much like the Bears of Baylor.

Those two games were of the most interest to me over the weekend but it is now time to move on to Week 3 of the college season. This week after watching a full weekend of college and pro football we wondered how teams would do if they won as a huge underdog the previous week and were once again installed as a large underdog.

After asking around the office and asking some of my friends the consensus was there would be a letdown and the team that won as a huge underdog would lose this week in that role. I queried our college football database and uncovered one of our systems that gives us the answer to that question. The old crystal ball has once again provided us a gem of a power system for this week's college games.

The system is simple after a major upset victory as a large home underdog teams that are back in a similar role of a big underdog they have not missed a beat they continue with their stellar play on the field and cash another winning ticket.

The system tells us to Play ON a non-conference underdog of 8.5-points to 21.5-points coming off a home straight up win as an underdog of at least eleven points facing an opponent not coming off a home favorite straight up loss. The parameters are simple and self-explanatory when you do not try to over think the situation it really is simple but powerful. This system has a record of 15-0 ATS which is solid it also not only covers the spread it does so with a double-digit average covering by 10.27 points per game. A short sample size will concern some but the fact we have a double-digit average against the number adds stability to this little gem.

With all the system parameters met our Cajun Sports Wire NCAA Football System Play of the Week calls for a play on the New Mexico State Aggies in their game against Kentucky on Saturday. We opened the season with a nice winner on Boston College last week on these pages let's keep winning with the Aggies of New Mexico State this week.

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# Pick Sixty Sports: Tips and Totals

There is a lot to take in during the first week of the NFL season. Some teams outperformed our expectations while others looked as if they were still in preseason mode, where every play doesn't have such a lasting impact on the outcome.

As we reset for Week 2 and another full slate of games, it's a worthwhile practice to look back at the box scores and see what exactly led to each team's victory or defeat. To run checks on the more extreme statistical measures from Week 1, you can utilize SDQL in virtually any department. Let's start with first downs. To get a clean look at which teams had the most/least first downs last week, just type in the following code:

SDQL Text: tS(first downs) @ team and week=1 and season=2016

Eight teams had more first downs in Week 1 than the league-high of 2015 (23.8), and Detroit and San Fran led the charge with 28 apiece. Based on that information we can run a quick query to see how teams do in Week 2 following such a strong offensive outburst. The answer is 16 overs, 6 unders and 3 pushes — a 73-percent trend to the over. Get the game list with this code:

SDQL Text: tp:first downs > 27 and week = 2

The translation is simple — Teams in Week 2 off a game where they registered more than 27 first downs. Try this process with parameters such as time of possession, points or rushing yards and develop your own winning strategies.

## SAVING IT UP

Here's how you run a check for home underdogs that were held scoreless during the first-half of the previous ballgame (SDQL: HD and p:P1 + p:P2 = 0)

The overall score suggests a 53-percent lean to the over (162-142-3 O/U) but when you isolate games that took place in Week 2, there is 12-2 O/U record that's worth noting. The over has hit 11-straight times since 2000 and on average, games in this profile are sailing over by nearly 13 points.

Minnesota is a home dog to Green Bay on Sunday night and the Vikes were down 10-0 through 30 minutes at Tennessee before the defense took over. Facing a much more powerful foe, it may seem unlikely that Minnesota's offense could do enough to win their next matchup and sure enough, teams off a win are on a 1-8 ATS run. See for yourself with this code:

SDQL Text: HD and p:P1 + p:P2 = 0 and p:AW

The past 10 totals produced 7 overs and 3 unders and all games with a total greater than 44 went 4-1 O/U. Green Bay plays well in Minnesota (6-3 SU and 6-3 O/U past nine, averaging 29.9 points) so

this short line is a testament to the Vikings defense. I'm circling this contest for a potential play on the weekend so be sure and check my site or Twitter feed for updates.

## DOUBLE VISION

If a football player is seeing double these days, he's usually in for a timeout in the 'quiet room'. In the case of the Detroit Lions and Oakland Raiders, I'm seeing double value this week with two teams whose setup is remarkably similar.

Each of these teams opened on the road against a non-conference foe and came out on top of a high scoring affair. The Lions took down Indy 39-35 while Oakland got past the Saints, 35-34. By virtue of their wins, each is laying more than a field goal at home this week against another non-conference foe. Current odds favor the Lions (-4.5) and Raiders (-5.5). In case you're wondering, the general trend for faves in this midrange is 41-23 SU and 35-29 ATS. They often win but are only covering at a pedestrian rate of 55-percent.

SDQL Text: H and p:AWO and not C and -7 < line < -3

There's more to these matchups, though. Each of these secondaries was shredded last week by a premier passer. It was indoors and away from home. In Oakland's case it was even an early body clock train. Excuses don't make the massive passing yards allowed any easier to take and now on home turf, it's time for these teams to build off their wins.

Non-conference home faves off a game where they allowed more than three passing touchdowns are 18-11 ATS. When the line is -6 points or less, the record improves to 11-4 ATS.

SDQL Text: po:passing touchdowns > 3 and HF and not C and line >= -6

Early season faves off losing years are looking to stay above .500 and in the case of the Lions and Raiders, each team has a solid red zone offense that can score. Oakland was 8th in the league last season at 61% and Detroit finished 2nd overall at 69%.

SDQL Text: tpA(red zones made) / tpA(red zones attempted) > 0.60 and week < 5 and t:PRSW < 8 and F

Using the above code we see a 69-percent angle "live" Sunday on both faves and when the spread was more than -3, the record improves to 12-3 ATS (80-percent). There have been six-straight covers since 2011 and the past four were by double-digits. For this week, I offer two selections.

Pick No. 1: Take the Lions

Pick No. 2: Take the Raiders

**Jets at Bills** - The Jets are 6-0-1 ats since Oct 15, 2000 when the line is within 3 of pick and vs a divisional opponent off a home loss. The Bills are 0-8 ats since Dec 01, 2013 and facing an opponent that allows a completion rate of more than 65 percent. The Bills are 7-0 ats since Nov 11, 2012 and vs a divisional opponent and after they made 4 or fewer third downs last game. The Jets are 0-7-1 ou since Sep 28, 2014 off a home game when the line is within 3 of pick. The Bills are 0-8 ou since Dec 28, 2008 off a road game as a dog on turf where they had zero turnovers.

**Colts at Broncos** - The Colts are 9-0 ats since Dec 04, 2011 and off a loss and as a dog and vs a non-divisional opponent. The Broncos are 0-6 ats since Oct 04, 2015 at home as a favorite.
